

PRO FORMA INVOICE FOR FREE SAMPLES

A free sample is still a customs shipment. Outside the European Union the goods cross a border, so they must be described, valued and declared even when they are given away.

HEADER

Shipper / exporter	Company name, full address, VAT number, EORI number, phone and e-mail.
Consignee	Company name and full address of the foreign consignee. If the buyer and the party physically receiving the goods differ, state both.
Pro forma number	Your own numbering, separate from your sales invoices.

Carrier and tracking number	
Incoterm and named place	The three letters alone are never enough: always add the place.

GOODS

Description of goods	HS code	Origin	Qty	Net weight	Gross weight	Unit value	Total value

The description of the goods must match, word for word, the description on the transport document and on every other document of the shipment.

THE TWO STATEMENTS, WRITTEN OUT IN FULL

Free samples of no commercial value.

Value declared for customs purposes only.

For the declared value, refer to the market value of the goods. A token value, such as one euro for a case of preserves, speeds nothing up: it makes an inspection more likely, and the inspection is the delay.

TO KEEP AFTER SHIPPING

Proof of exit from the European Union	The exporting company must hold it, exactly as for a sale.
